Position Scope: Seeking a part time individual interested in a position providing vital services to our ever growing aging population in both DuPage and Kane County. An ideal candidate would be self-motivated, highly organized, and have customer service skills. Another major requirement is having experience with an aging population. Candidates that have worked with in food handling service is a plus.

Responsibilities/Tasks:

- Maintains accurate records for nutrition participants, meals served, volunteers, and volunteer hours as outlined by DSCC.
- Assures that all food service sanitation standards are practiced at the site by staff and volunteers as outlined by the DSCC.
- Enforce volunteer and staff polices.
- Tracks the daily meal requests and cancellations for home delivered meal clients and community diners.
- Reports data to the DSCC central office.
- Operates the DSCC scanning device to maintain daily meal counts & volunteer hours.
- Maintains and submits updated information for DSCC route sheets (master copy & daily route sheets utilized by volunteers' drivers).
- Attends all nutrition staff meetings, in-services and special events, including weekend events.
- Implements DSCC Health & Wellness program activities at the site as directed.
- Refers potential new volunteers to the Volunteer Recruiter at DSCC central office.
- Maintains site-specific volunteer schedule, maintains & submits updates to the volunteer roster.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

Qualifications/Skills Desired:

- Must pass the State of Illinois Food Service Sanitation course and maintain the certification.
- Position requires a vehicle with valid license plates, insurance and driver's license.
- Able to lift 50lbs
- Must be able to read a map, along with being able to write and follow driving directions.
- Position requires travel to DuPage & Kane County.
- Basic knowledge of a computer & information technology is a must for this position.
